VALMIKI

He was born along the banks of the Ganges in ancient India to a sage named Prachetsa. His birth name was Ratnakara. He apparently got lost in the jungles as a child and was found by a hunter who raised him as his own son.



Rama and Ravana had a crazy and intense battle of arrows, after Ravana realized about the help of the god to Rama, Ravana rages and multiplies his arms to twenty and a head to ten heads.

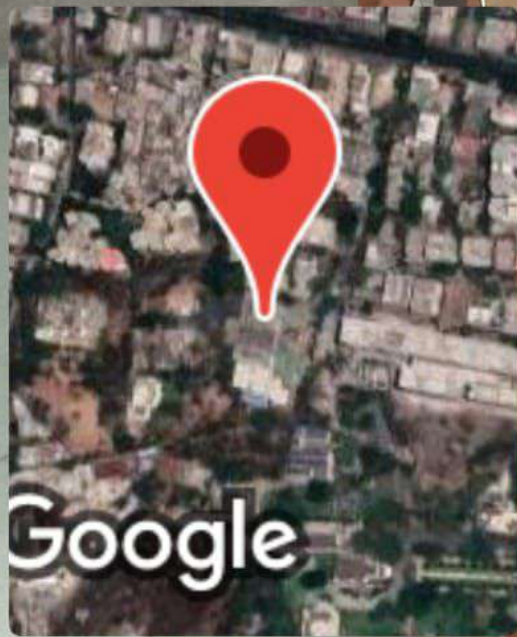
