4. Roadmap to MBA Journey: 12-Feb-2024

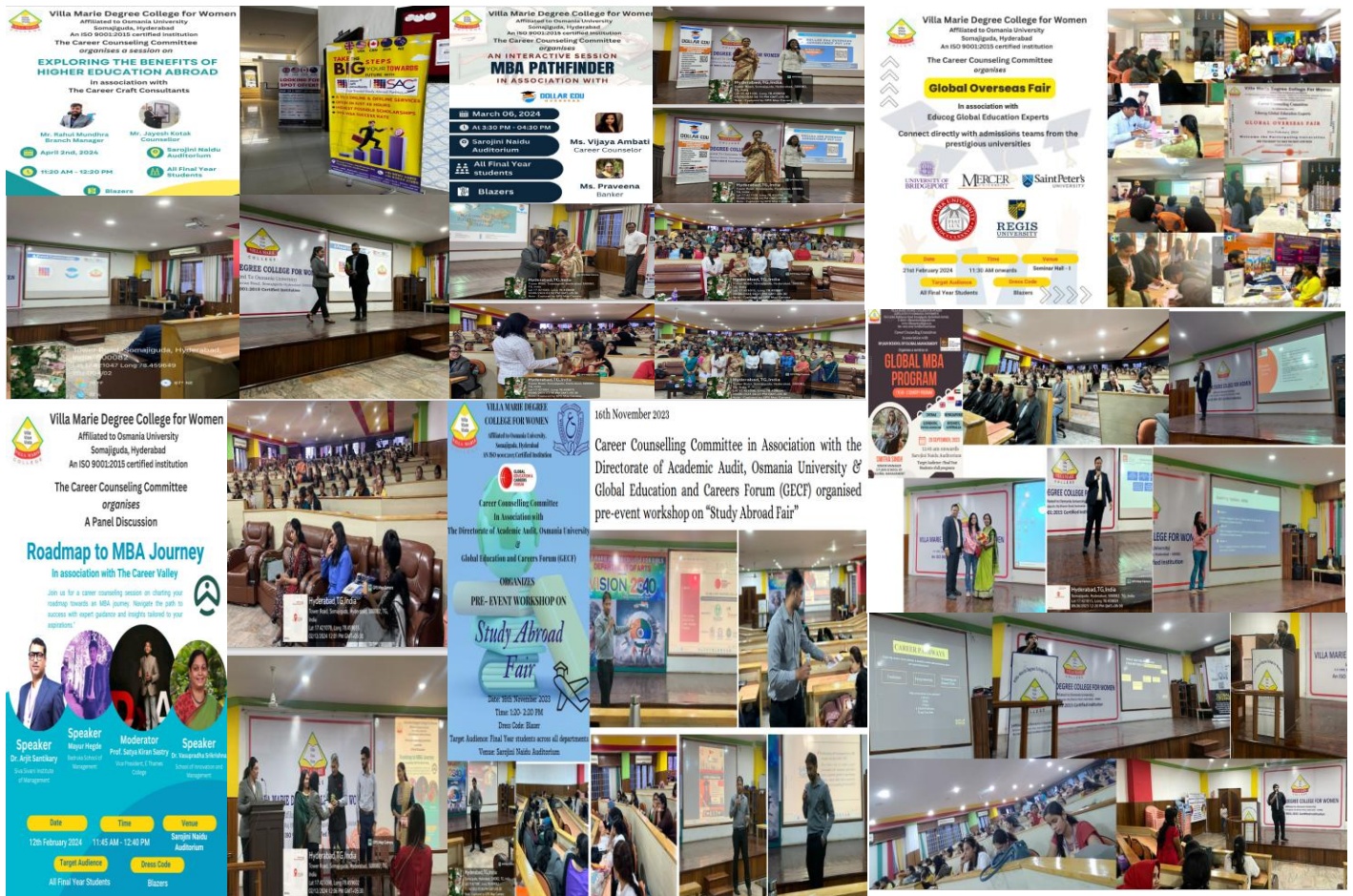
