

REPORT - 2023-2024

Throughout the academic year, the Literary Committee organized a series of vibrant events, celebrating culture, literature, and student leadership. These activities enhanced students' knowledge of cultural traditions and promoted leadership skills. A brief report on key events:

- **Alumni Lecture on Edgar Allan Poe (January 19, 2024):** The Literary Committee and the Department of English organized a lecture on Poe's birth anniversary. Alumna Serena Ahluwalia led an engaging session on Poe's Gothic themes, exploring his works' focus on madness, death, and the human psyche.
