Career Counseling Committee Report

Academic Year 2025-26

The Career Counseling Committee of Villa Marie Degree College for Women organized a series of career guidance, higher education awareness, and skill development programs during the Academic Year 2025--2026. These initiatives aimed to empower students with global exposure, career planning, higher education opportunities, internship awareness, and competitive examination preparation.

The first major event, **“Higher Education Abroad Fair – Your Gateway to World-Class Education”**, was conducted on **30 January 2026** in collaboration with **TEG – The Education Group**. The fair brought together representatives from 15 international universities and provided students with valuable information regarding overseas education opportunities, admissions, scholarships, visa procedures, and career pathways. Students interacted directly with university representatives and gained clarity about pursuing higher education abroad.

On **25 February 2026**, the committee organized a workshop on **“Speed Maths Techniques & Myths Busted About CAT & MBA in India”** in association with **IMS Hyderabad**. The session focused on enhancing students’ quantitative aptitude skills through shortcut methods and logical strategies while also addressing misconceptions regarding CAT preparation, MBA admissions, specializations, placements, and career prospects. The workshop motivated students to consider management education as a viable career option.

To encourage global learning experiences, an orientation session on **“Discover Global Opportunity – Powered by AIESEC”** was conducted on **5 March 2026**. The session introduced students to international internships, volunteer programs, and global exchange opportunities. Participants gained insights into leadership development, cultural awareness, communication skills, and professional networking opportunities available through AIESEC programs.

Further strengthening students’ career readiness, an **Orientation Session on Summer Internship Programs** was organized on **10 April 2026**. The resource person from the University of Wolverhampton provided practical guidance on internship application strategies, industry expectations, skill requirements, and international internship opportunities. The session helped students understand the importance of internships in enhancing employability and career growth. Through these initiatives, the Career Counseling Committee successfully created awareness about higher education opportunities, global exposure programs, internships, and career development pathways. The programs significantly enhanced students’ confidence, employability skills, decision-making abilities, and preparedness for future academic and professional endeavors, reaffirming the institution’s commitment to holistic student development and career excellence.
